


Guide for Initial WebAssign Access

Math 1160, 1500, 1700, 2300

LOG IN

Your WebAssign and Blackboard courses are linked, so initial access to WebAssign must be through Blackboard. DO NOT go to www.webassign.com and try to type in a username and password for your initial access. Your WebAssign access is set up for you through the Blackboard roster. Please follow the directions below for initial access.


1. Log in to Blackboard at <https://courses.missouri.edu>.
2. Select your course site.
3. Once you have entered your course site, select the WebAssign menu tab on the left of the course home screen.
If you do not see this tab, alert your TA or Instructor right away. The tab could be hidden from student view.
