Stephen Montgomery-Smith moved that consideration of fields for recruiting next academic year be deferred until after hiring this year is complete; Stamatis Dostoglou seconded the motion.

Stephen Montgomery-Smith amended the motion to state that the consideration of fields for recruiting during the next academic year be conducted during the Spring Semester 2011 after hiring this academic year is completed. Seconded by Jan Segert
